Baldwins Lane Post Office Previously located at: 295 Baldwins Lane, Croxley Green, Rickmansworth, WD3 3LE

We are delighted to let you know that following the temporary closure of Baldwins Lane Post Office, we will be re-opening the branch on Wednesday 5 May 2021 at 13:00. This will be in a new location – Spar, 47-49 Baldwins Lane, Croxley Green, WD3 3LS.

In conjunction with the re-opening of the branch, for the first six months we're trialling a new type of Post Office service.

At Post Office we are continually looking to make sure we meet ever-changing customer demand and ensure our network plan continues to evolve accordingly. One of the ways we're doing this is to try out some additional Post Office formats on a small scale before we look at any potential wider introduction in the network.

During the trial of the new style branch we will monitor usage, suitability and any local feedback on the new service. If there is a need to change the service, posters will be displayed locally to let customers know.

We will display posters in the new location to tell customers the good news. If you are a local representative it would be helpful if you could share this information through your social media channels and with any local groups or organisations that you know within the community, for example on noticeboards, local charities and in GP surgeries, to help our customers and your constituents understand what is happening to the Post Office in the local community. If you would like a supply of these posters please let us know.

We are keen to restore services to this community as soon as possible, so we have decided to go ahead with our plans. However we would welcome suggestions about specific aspects of the change particularly on the following areas:

- Do you have any comments about access into the new premises?
- Do you have any comments about access inside the new premises?

We will be accepting comments until Friday 28 May 2021. We won't be responding to you individually, but any comments received will be taken into consideration as we finalise our plans.

Principles of Community Engagement on changes to the Post Office network (extract)

We are committed to engaging and supporting our customers and their representatives as we make changes to the Post Office network. The following Principles will be adopted when communicating about changes to your local Post Office branch.

We will **Notify** - where we are informing customers of changes around:

- Opening hours
- Temporary closure¹/ temporary service interruption
- Re-opening of a temporarily closed branch in the same site
- Opening a new branch unrelated to a previous closure
- Location used by a Mobile Post Office within a community

We will display a poster in branch (or nearby if appropriate) to notify customers of the above changes, providing four weeks' notice. Where four weeks' notice is not possible, we will provide notice as soon as we are able to. For temporary closures we will include details of the nearest alternative Post Offices and our customer helpline/textphone.

These Principles have been agreed with Citizens Advice, Citizens Advice Scotland and the General Consumer Council for Northern Ireland; the independent statutory consumer watchdogs.

What to do if you feel these Principles haven't been followed:

Please get in touch so we can investigate your complaint. We'll explain in our reply whether we believe we have followed our Principles of Community Engagement and will provide you with the contact details for the relevant consumer watchdog (Citizens Advice, Citizens Advice Scotland or the Consumer Council for Northern Ireland) if you're not satisfied with our response. The watchdog will independently assess whether we have followed the Principles of Community Engagement process (rather than the decision itself) and recommend any actions with respect to the complaint.

¹ There may be a small number of cases where due to circumstances outside our control we have no option other than to permanently close a branch in a particular location. In these cases, the consultation will seek feedback on alternative Post Office service provision in the area.

We notify locally elected representatives including but are not restricted to the Member of Parliament, Scottish Parliament, Welsh Assembly, or Northern Ireland Assembly, Local Authority Chief Executive, Ward Councillors, Parish or Community Council, selected charities, local Citizens Advice, Age UK, Northern Ireland's Disability Action and Northern Ireland's Rural Community Network. They are also encouraged to share all information additionally with local groups and organisations who they believe have an active interest in changes to their local Post Office
