# Ballygrant Post Office<sup>®</sup> Ballygrant Village Hall, Ballygrant, Isle of Islay, PA45 7QR

I am writing to confirm that we have proceeded with our proposal to re-open a Hosted Outreach Post Office service at the above location.

We received one individual comment from the local representative during the consultation period. The feedback centred on the reduced opening hours and some customers who may have difficulty getting access to Post Office services via alternative Post Office branches. This feedback enabled me to improve my understanding of concerns and to ensure that all such information was taken into account before finalising our plans for the new service.

Due to operational reasons the service did not commence on Monday 5 February 2018 as previously advised and please accept our apologies regarding this. I can confirm the Hosted Outreach Post Office service commenced on Tuesday 22 May 2018 and is operating on Mondays between 13:30 - 15:30.

The core Postmaster from Bowmore Post Office has re-opened the Hosted Outreach service from inside the Ballygrant Village Hall. We do understand that for some customers the opening times may be less convenient than for others. However, we do consider that the new opening times reflect customer usage, and will allow us to maintain a Post Office service to the community for the longer term. We will continue to review and monitor service on an on-going basis and should customer usage increase significantly, consideration would be given to adjusting service times accordingly.

I have carefully considered my original proposal, and the feedback received during the public consultation period. I am confident that the Hosted Outreach service meets the needs of our customers in the local community.
