Local Public Consultation Decision

I'm writing to confirm that we will be proceeding with our proposal to move the above Post Office branch to Northview Service Station, Chilton Moor Filling Station, Colliery Row, Houghton Le Spring, DH4 5NW, where it will operate as one of our new local style Post Office branches.

We received 10 individual responses from customers during the local public consultation period. Some feedback welcomed the move to Northview Service Station, which was said to be closer for some people, would offer more space inside the shop and longer opening times. Other feedback commented about the extra distance some people would have to travel and parking. This feedback helped me to understand customers' views and to make sure that all such information was taken into account before finalising our plans.

I appreciate that the proposed location is approximately 450 metres from the current site and that for some of our customers this will mean a slightly longer journey. In situations like this there will always be some people who are more inconvenienced than others for which I apologise. Equally, as we know from feedback received, there are other customers for whom the new location will be slightly closer and more convenient to access than at present. In term of access to the new location, there are well maintained pavements and dropped kerbs along the route for customers choosing to walk to the new branch and for those using public transport, there is a bus service operating from Front Street with a bus stop in close vicinity of the Northview Service Station.

We recognise that the Post Office plays an important part in the lives of customers, particularly for our elderly and disabled customers, and we want to make our services as accessible as possible. Before the new Post Office opens, the new operator will mark out pedestrian walkways across the garage forecourt to provide a clear route from the pavement and parking areas to the shop entrance. There will be parking spaces on the garage forecourt and one of these will be marked out as a designated disabled parking bay close to the shop entrance.

With regard to customer comments about parking, I have conducted a further review. This has confirmed that as well as the parking spaces on the garage forecourt, there is ample roadside parking in the surrounding area. I am therefore satisfied that there is adequate parking at and in the vicinity of the proposed branch to meet customer requirements.

I am also pleased to confirm that the new operator plans to carry out a complete refurbishment of the premises and extend the existing shop. The new branch will be built in line with Post Office specifications, making sure there is sufficient space for the new style local Post Office to operate alongside the retail offer. We will be working closely with the new operator on the internal layout to make sure there is clear access into the shop and customers can move about and access Post Office services without difficulty. There will be level access with a wide door at the entrance.

The new local style Post Office will operate from a Post Office serving point located at the shop counter, enabling customers to carry out a wide range of Post Office products and services alongside retail transactions. The Post Office transactions are designed to be quick and efficient to enable fast and effective customer service and helping to reduce queuing. This does mean that a small number of transactions that are more time consuming, complex or paper based won't be available at the new branch. However, I can confirm that the new branch will still cater for the vast majority of Post Office products and services. The very small range of services that will no longer be offered, can be accessed at Houghton Le Spring Post Office, which offers the full range of Post Office products and services and can be reached by a direct bus service.

The change also means that customers will benefit from extensive opening hours, including lunch times, Wednesday and Saturday afternoon, Sunday opening and longer opening times throughout the week, so they can use our services seven days a week and at times that suit them better. Further details of the new branch are provided at the end of this letter together with a list of the products and services which will be available.

I have carefully considered our original proposal, the feedback received during the local public consultation period along with the impact on local residents and the wider community. Having also reviewed pedestrian and vehicular access to the new site, I am confident that the new branch is suitably located and that this new way of offering Post Office services will meet customer needs, whilst helping to provide long term viability and future sustainability for Post Office service provision in the local community.

The current branch closed on Monday 2 July 2018 and the new branch will open, at Northview Service Station, Chilton Moor Filling Station, Colliery Row, at 13:00 on Thursday 12 July 2018. Please accept our apologies for any inconvenience caused.

If there are any unforeseen schedule changes which mean these dates change, posters will be displayed in Northview Service Station to let customers know. During this period of temporary closure customers requiring Post Office services may use any convenient Post Office branch. Details of two alternative Post Office branches are provided below for your convenience:
