Local Public Consultation Decision

I'm writing to confirm that we will be proceeding with our proposal to move the above Post Office branch to 900 Burnley Road, Todmorden, OL14 8PJ, where it will operate as one of our new local style Post Office branches.

We received 1 response during the local public consultation period which welcomed the ease of access and longer opening times that would be available at the new location. I have carried out a final review of our original proposal and the feedback received during the local public consultation period. I have also reviewed pedestrian and vehicular access to the new site along with the impact on local residents and the wider community.

I was pleased to learn of the positive feedback and we are also delighted that this branch is part of the modernisation plans for our network, offering Post Office services that will meet customer needs whilst helping to provide long term viability and future sustainability. We already have over 3800 branches offering Post Office services in this new way and customer and operator feedback has been very encouraging.

It's clear that the Post Office plays an important part in the lives of customers, particularly to older and disabled customers and we want to make our services as accessible as possible. Our new operator fully understands they are responsible for making sure that their premises meet with all relevant legislation and I am pleased to confirm that they will be making adjustments to improve access for customers. Before the new Post Office opens a permanent ramp will be installed, providing ease of access into the premises.

Internally the new branch will be in line with Post Office specifications, making sure there is sufficient space for the new style local Post Office to operate alongside the retail offer. We will be working closely with the new operator in the internal layout and some fixtures and fittings will be re-aligned or removed to make sure there is unimpeded access into the premises. Aisles will be kept free from obstructions, with sufficient space for a wheelchair to move around the shop and access the Post Office service point.

I appreciate that the new location is approximately 950 metres away from the current site. In situations such as this there will always be some customers who are more inconvenienced than others and I acknowledge for some customers this may mean a slightly longer journey, for which I apologise. Equally, there may be some customers for whom the new location is slightly closer than at present. In terms of accessing the new location, there is a frequent bus service (route 592 & 589) from the current branch which stops approximately 60 metres from new site. Customers can also access the full range of Post Office products and services at Todmorden Post Office, which can be reached by a regular bus service.

The new local style Post Office will operate from an open plan till, located at the shop counter, enabling customers to carry out a wide range of Post Office products and services alongside retail transactions. The change also means that local residents will benefit from significantly longer opening hours, including Tuesday and Saturday afternoon, Sunday and longer opening times throughout the week, so customers can use our services at times that suit them better. Details of the new service are provided at the end of this letter together with a product list, which lets you know which services will be available at your new branch.

The current branch will close at 12:30 on Saturday 20 January 2018, with the new branch opening, at 900 Burnley Road, at 13:00 on Monday 22 January 2018. If there are any unforeseen schedule changes which mean these dates change, posters will be displayed in branch to let customers know. During transfer of the branch customers requiring Post Office facilities may use any convenient Post Office service.
