

Dear Customer

Dudley Post Office West View, Dudley, Cramlington, NE23 7AB

We're writing to let you know that we're changing the above Post Office to one of our Local style branches.

Customers will access Post Office services at a low-screened, open-plan, modern serving point that's part of the retail counter. Working with our partner, we'd adapt the current store layout, fixtures and fittings to accommodate the Post Office till if needed.

The branch will offer a similar range of Post Office products and services and the new opening hours will be Monday to Sunday 08:00 – 20:00, so customers can access their Post Office when it's convenient. Customer satisfaction with local style branches is high, and many local branch customers visit outside traditional opening hours.

Customers will still be able to get most of the Post Office products and services they are used to, however, for a small number of services they may need to go on-line, call us or visit an alternative Post Office. Paper-based, manual transactions will not be available, details of product availability are provided below.

To make the changes, the branch will also undergo a refurbishment and the safety of our customers is of paramount importance to us. Therefore, to allow for the refurbishments to take place, it will be necessary for the service to close, temporarily, on Thursday 30 March 2023 at 17:30. It is envisaged, the works will take approximately 4 weeks to complete. Following which, your new-look Post Office will open at this location on Thursday 27 April 2023 at 08:00.

If there are any unforeseen circumstances which mean these dates change, posters will be displayed in branch to let customers know.

During the temporary branch closure, customers requiring Post Office facilities may use any convenient Post Office service. Details of alternative Post Office branches are provided at the end of this letter.

We're carrying out this notification in line with our Principles of Community Engagement. An extract relating to Notification is available at the end of this letter.

Principles of Community Engagement on changes to the Post Office network (extract)

We are committed to engaging and supporting our customers and their representatives as we make changes to the Post Office network. The following Principles will be adopted when communicating about changes to your local Post Office branch.

We will **<u>Notify</u>** - where we are informing customers of changes around:

- Opening hours
- Temporary closure¹/ temporary service interruption
- Re-opening of a temporarily closed branch in the same site
- Opening a new branch unrelated to a previous closure
- Location used by a Mobile Post Office within a community

We will display a poster in branch (or nearby if appropriate) to notify customers of the above changes, providing four weeks' notice. Where four weeks' notice is not possible, we will provide notice as soon as we are able to. For temporary closures we will include details of the nearest alternative Post Offices and our customer helpline/textphone.

These Principles have been agreed with Citizens Advice, Citizens Advice Scotland and the General Consumer Council for Northern Ireland; the independent statutory consumer watchdogs.

What to do if you feel these Principles haven't been followed:

Please get in touch so we can investigate your complaint. We'll explain in our reply whether we believe we have followed our Principles of Community Engagement and will provide you with the contact details for the relevant consumer watchdog (Citizens Advice, Citizens Advice Scotland or the Consumer Council for Northern Ireland) if you're not satisfied with our response. The watchdog will independently assess whether we have followed the Principles of Community Engagement process (rather than the decision itself) and recommend any actions with respect to the complaint.

¹ We will provide an update to locally elected representatives if the status of the temporarily closed branch has not changed after 12 months.

There may be a small number of cases where due to circumstances outside our control we have no option other than to permanently close a branch in a particular location. In these cases, the consultation will seek feedback on alternative Post Office service provision in the area.

We notify locally elected representatives including but are not restricted to the Member of Parliament, Scottish Parliament, Welsh Parliament, or Northern Ireland Assembly, Local Authority Chief Executive, Ward Councillors, Parish or Community Council, selected charities, local Citizens Advice, Age UK, Northern Ireland's Disability Action and Northern Ireland's Rural Community Network. They are also encouraged to share all information additionally with local groups and organisations who they believe have an active interest in changes to their local Post Office.
