Changes to Fritwell Outreach Services

Affecting Somerton Stoney, Middleton Stoney, Bucknell, Upper Heyford, Barford St Michael and Souldern Outreach Services

We are writing to inform you that, regrettably, due to low customer usage the services at Somerton Stoney, Middleton Stoney, Bucknell, Upper Heyford, operated by the Postmaster from Fritwell Post Office has become unsustainable to operate, and therefore these services will all cease on the following date: Thursday 25 July 2024, Somerton Outreach Service at 11:05, Middleton Stoney Outreach Service at 13:15, Bucknell Outreach Service at 14:20 and Upper Heyford Outreach Service at 12:10.

The Post Office has undertaken a comprehensive review of the network provision to ensure that it continues to meet evolving customer needs in a very challenging economic climate. This review examined the network at a very detailed, local level, analysing customer demand and accessibility of Post Office products and services. Consequently, it has informed our plans for the Post Office network as we work to ensure that, our funding and resources are allocated to deliver maximum benefit for all customers. As a result, we are not currently looking to replace the services at Somerton Stoney, Middleton Stoney, Bucknell and Upper Heyford.

Along with the closures, there will be some changes to the current opening hours at Barford St Michael and Souldern Outreach Post Office services, these changes will take effect week commencing Thursday 1 August 2024, Barford St Michael Outreach Service at 10:30 and Souldern Outreach Service at 12:15.

We apologise for the inconvenience the unplanned closures may cause. We hope that our customers will continue to use Post Office services and details of alternative Post Office branches in the area are shown at the end of this letter. Principles of Community Engagement on changes to the Post Office network (extract)

We are committed to engaging and supporting our customers and their representatives as we make changes to the Post Office network. The following Principles will be adopted when communicating about changes to your local Post Office branch.

We will **Notify** - where we are informing customers of changes around:

- Opening hours
- Unplanned closure¹/ planned service interruption
- Re-opening of a closed branch in the same site
- Opening a new branch unrelated to a previous closure
- Location used by a Mobile Post Office within a community
- Franchising of a Directly Managed branch in its existing site where there are no changes to access to the Post Office serving point

We will display a poster in branch (or nearby if appropriate) to notify customers of the above changes, aiming to provide four weeks' notice. Four weeks' notice may not be possible for an unplanned change, and in these instances, we will provide notice as soon as we are able to. For closures we will include details of the nearest alternative Post Offices and our customer helpline/textphone.

We notify locally elected representatives including but are not restricted to the Member of Parliament, Scottish Parliament, Welsh Parliament, or Northern Ireland Assembly, Local Authority Chief Executive, Ward Councillors, Parish or Community Council, selected charities, local Citizens Advice, Age UK, Northern Ireland's Disability Action and Northern Ireland's Rural Community Network. They are also encouraged to share all information additionally with local groups and organisations who they believe have an active interest in changes to their local Post Office.

These Principles have been agreed with Citizens Advice, Consumer Scotland and the General Consumer Council for Northern Ireland, the independent statutory consumer watchdogs.

What to do if you feel these Principles haven't been followed:

Please get in touch so we can investigate your complaint. We'll explain in our reply whether we believe we have followed our Principles of Community Engagement and will provide you with the contact details for the relevant consumer watchdog (Citizens Advice, Consumer Scotland, or the Consumer Council for Northern Ireland) if you're not satisfied with our response. The watchdog will independently assess whether we have followed the Principles of Community Engagement process (rather than the decision itself) and recommend any actions with respect to the complaint.
