Local Public Consulation Decision

I'm writing to confirm that we will be proceeding with our proposal to move the above Post Office branch to Costcutter, 36 Bicester Road, Launton, Bicester, OX26 5DQ, where it will operate as one of our new local style Post Office branches.

We received 59 individual responses from customers and local representatives during the local public consultation period. Some of the feedback commented on parking and the availability of space inside the premises. Other feedback welcomed the move to the new location, which was said to be closer for some people and offered longer opening times.

I appreciate that the proposed location is approximately 230 metres from the current site. In situations such as this there will always be some people who are more inconvenienced than others and I acknowledge for some customers this may mean a longer journey, for which I apologise. Equally, as we know from customer feedback, there are other customers for whom the new location is closer and more convenient than at present.

With regards to parking in the area, it is fair to say that this is a problem faced generally in many locations nationwide. As I am sure you will understand, the availability of parking spaces is outside the direct control of Post Office Limited, however I have further reviewed parking and can confirm that there is parking on the forecourt of the premises. I am also pleased to confirm that the new operator will mark out a dedicated disabled bay on the forecourt before the new branch opens. I am therefore satisfied that parking will continue to be adequate to meet customer demand.

We recognise that the Post Office plays an important part in the lives of customers, particularly to elderly and disabled customers, and we want to make our services as accessible as possible. Access will be via a permanent ramp with a wide automatic door and handrails at the entrance. Inside the shop, the new branch will be in line with Post Office specifications, making sure there is sufficient space for the new style local Post Office to operate alongside the retail offer. We will be working closely with the new operator on the internal layout and some fixtures and fittings will be re-aligned or removed to make sure there is clear access into the premises. Aisles and the queuing area will be kept free from obstructions and adequate room will be provided for customers and a wheelchair to move around the shop and access Post Office services.

To further support our customers in accessing the new branch, the new operator will be approaching the relevant authority to seek the provision of a hatched walkway across the forecourt, from the pavement to the entrance of the store, to ensure this area is kept free of obstructions including parked vehicles.

The new local style Post Office will operate from a Post Office serving point located at the retail counter enabling customers to carry out a wide range of Post Office products and services alongside retail transactions. The Post Office transactions are designed to be quick and efficient to operate to enable fast and effective customer service and helping to reduce queuing. This does mean that a small number of transactions that are more time consuming, complex or paper based won't be available at the new branch. However, I can confirm that the new branch will still cater for the vast majority of Post Office products and services. The very small number of services that will no longer be offered can be accessed at Bicester Post Office which can be reached by a regular bus service.

The change also means that Post Office opening hours are aligned to the shop so local residents will benefit from significantly longer opening hours, including lunch times, Saturday afternoon, Sunday opening and longer opening times throughout the week. This means that customers can spread their visits and access our services seven days a week and at times that suit them better, which also helps to reduce waiting times and relieve any potential congestion. Full details of the new branch are provided at the end of this letter together with a list of the products and services which will be available.

I have carefully considered our original proposal, the feedback received during the public consultation period and the impact on local residents and the wider community. Having also reviewed pedestrian and vehicular access to the new site, I remain satisfied that the new branch is suitably located and that this new way of offering Post Office services will continue to meet customer needs, whilst helping to provide long term viability and future sustainability for Post Office service provision in the local community.

The current branch will close at 17:30 on Tuesday 12 September 2017, with the new branch opening, at Costcutter, 36 Bicester Road, at 13:00 on Wednesday 27 September 2017. If there are any unforeseen schedule changes which mean these dates change, posters will be displayed in branch to let customers know. During transfer of the branch customers requiring Post Office facilities may use any convenient Post Office service. Details of two alternative Post Office branches are provided below for your convenience:

- Bicester Post Office, 20 Sheep Street, Bicester, OX26 6TB
- Bassett Avenue Post Office, 9 Bassett Avenue, Bicester, OX26 4TZ
