Local Public Consultation Decision

I'm writing to confirm that we will be preceeding with our proposal to move the above Post Office branch to Leysdown Pharmacy, 9a Leysdown Road, Leysdown on Sea, Sheerness, ME12 4RE, where it will operate as one of our new local style Post Office branches.

We received 1 individual response from a customer during the local public consultation period. The feedback commented about access into the proposed store. This feedback helped me to understand customers' concerns and to make sure that all such information was taken into account before finalising our plans.

It's clear that the Post Office plays an important part in the lives of customers, particularly to elderly and disabled customers and we want to make our services as accessible as we possibly can. Access at the store will be via a wide door and a permanent ramp. A handrail will be installed at the entrance.


Internally the new branch will be in line with Post Office specifications, making sure there is sufficient space for the Post Office service to operate alongside the retail offer. We will be working closely with the new operator on the internal layout and some fixtures and fittings will be re-aligned or removed to make sure there is clear access into the premises, ensuring the entrance, aisles and the waiting area are kept free from obstructions and adequate room is provided for customers and a wheelchair to move around without difficulty.

Although the local style format is a different way of offering Post Office services, it does not compromise the professional service standards that we provide at all of our branches. We will be working with the new operator to make sure there is an appropriate level of privacy at the Post Office serving point. For example, we discuss issues like queue layout and asking customers to stand back from the counter whilst they are waiting for service. Similarly with security, as with any other branch in our network there would be strict guidelines and measures put in place to safeguard customers, staff and the cash and stock entrusted to the operator's care.

The new local style Post Office will operate from a till on the retail counter enabling customers to carry out a wide range of Post Office products and services alongside retail transactions. This includes the facility to collect undeliverable items of mail.

The change also means that local residents will benefit from longer opening hours, including Wednesday afternoons, and longer opening times throughout the week, allowing customers to spread their visits and access our services at times that suit them better. Full details of the new branch are provided at the end of this letter together with a list of the products and services currently available.

I have carefully considered our original proposal and the feedback received during the local public consultation period, along with the impact on local residents and the wider community. Having also reviewed pedestrian and vehicular access to the new site, I am confident that the new branch is suitably located and that this new way of offering Post Office services will continue to meet customer needs, whilst helping to provide long term viability and future sustainability for Post Office service provision in the local community.





The current branch closed at 17:30 on Thursday 20 April 2017, with the new branch opening, at Leysdown Pharmacy, 9a Leysdown Road, at 13:00 on Friday 21 April 2017. If there are any unforeseen schedule changes which means these dates change, posters will be displayed in branch to let customer know. During transfer of the branch customers requiring Post Office facilities may use any convenient Post Office service.
