## **Service Re-opening**

## Llanfachraeth Mobile Service

Affecting Llanfaelog, Bodffordd, Bryngwran, Malltraeth, Newborough, Dwyran 2, Llandegfan, Llanddona, Bethel, Deiniolen, Moelfre, Rhosybol, Eglwys, Rowen, Henryd, Dwygyfylchi, Tal Y Bont 2, Penrhosgarnedd, Deganwy, Deganwy 2, Capel Curig, Dolwyddelan and Pentrefoelas Mobile services

We are pleased to advise that we have restored the Mobile services above, previously offered under Llanfachraeth Mobile service. The Postmaster at Betws-Y-Coed Post Office now operates the Mobile services, as part of the Betws-Y-Coed Mobile service and commenced on 5 November 2024. Please accept my apologies for the late notification on this occasion.

Additionally, the Deganwy Mobile service which was located at Deganwy Station, Station Road, Deganwy, Conwy, LL31 9EJ has now merged with the Deganwy 2 Mobile service operating at Co-op, Pentywyn Road, Deganwy, Conwy, LL31 9TG with new operating hours.

The Llanfaelog Mobile service previously operating from Gladdwr Shop The Wayside, Llanfaelog, Anglesey, LL63 5SY is now operating at a new location: Village Hall Car Park, Llanfaelog, Anglesey, LL63 5SS also with new operating hours. Full details of these service changes are provided at the end of this letter.

There will also need to be some changes to the current services offered by Betws-Y-Coed Mobile van, to accommodate these changes, affecting the opening times at Newborough, Llandegfan, Llanddona, Bethel, Deiniolen, Moelfre, Rhosybol, Eglwys Bach, Rowen, Henryd and Penrhosgarnedd Mobile services. Further details of the changes to these services are provided at the end of this letter.

As you may be aware, Capel Curig, Dolwyddelan and Pentrefoelas Outreach services, part of the current Betws-Y-Coed Outreach service, closed recently. Since these closures, the Postmaster at Betws-Y-Coed continued to work to identify a solution to restore Post Office services to these communities and I can confirm that they have successfully been restored as Mobile services.

I know that the local community will join me in welcoming this good news and hope that you and our customers will continue to use this service. If you are a local representative, please feel free to share this information through your social media channels and with any local groups or organisations that you know within the community for example on noticeboards, local charities and in GP surgeries, to help our customers and your constituents understand what is happening to the Post Office in the local community. If you would like a supply of posters, please let us know.

If you have any questions you would like to raise about this matter, please write to me via the National Consultation Team at the address shown at the end of the letter. Please note that your comments will not be kept confidential unless you expressly ask us to do so by clearly marking them "In Confidence".

We're carrying out this notification in line with our Principles of Community. An extract relating to Notification is available at the end of this letter.

## Principles of Community Engagement on changes to the Post Office network (extract)

We are committed to engaging and supporting our customers and their representatives as we make changes to the Post Office network. The following Principles will be adopted when communicating about changes to your local Post Office branch.

We will **Notify** - where we are informing customers of changes around:

- Opening hours
- Unplanned closure<sup>1</sup>/ planned service interruption
- Re-opening of a closed branch in the same site
- Opening a new branch unrelated to a previous closure
- Location used by a Mobile Post Office within a community
- Franchising of a Directly Managed branch in its existing site where there are no changes to access to the Post Office serving point

We will display a poster in branch (or nearby if appropriate) to notify customers of the above changes, aiming to provide four weeks' notice. Four weeks' notice may not be possible for an unplanned change, and in these instances, we will provide notice as soon as we are able to. For closures we will include details of the nearest alternative Post Offices and our customer helpline/textphone.

We notify locally elected representatives including but are not restricted to the Member of Parliament, Scottish Parliament, Welsh Parliament, or Northern Ireland Assembly, Local Authority Chief Executive, Ward Councillors, Parish or Community Council, selected charities, local Citizens Advice, Age UK, Northern Ireland's Disability Action and Northern Ireland's Rural Community Network. They are also encouraged to share all information additionally with local groups and organisations who they believe have an active interest in changes to their local Post Office.

These Principles have been agreed with Citizens Advice, Consumer Scotland and the General Consumer Council for Northern Ireland, the independent statutory consumer advocacy bodies.

## What to do if you feel these Principles haven't been followed:

Please get in touch so we can investigate your complaint. We'll explain in our reply whether we believe we have followed our Principles of Community Engagement and will provide you with the contact details for the relevant consumer advocacy body (Citizens Advice, Consumer Scotland, or the Consumer Council for Northern Ireland) if you're not satisfied with our response. The consumer advocacy body will independently assess whether we have followed the Principles of Community Engagement process (rather than the decision itself) and recommend any actions with respect to the complaint.
