### **Local Public Consultation Decision**

I am writing to confirm that we will be proceeding with our proposal to relocate this service to Leeds City Council (Offices), Deacon House, 1 Seacroft Avenue, Seacroft, Leeds, LS14 6JD.

We received no comments from customers or local representatives during the consultation period. I have carefully considered my original proposal and I am therefore confident that the relocation is the correct course of action to take.

The current branch will close at 17:30 on Wednesday 21 June 2017, with the new branch opening, at Leeds City Council (Offices), Deacon House, 1 Seacroft Avenue at 09:00 on Friday 30 June 2017. If there are any unforeseen schedule changes which mean these dates change, posters will be displayed in branch to let customers know. During this short period of closure customers requiring Post Office facilities may use any convenient Post Office service. Details of two alternative Post Office branches are provided below for your convenience:

• Skelton Wood Post Office, 40 Whitelaithe Approach, Leeds, LS14 2EH

• Kentmere Avenue Post Office, 141 South Parkway, Leeds, LS14 6ER

Posters will now be displayed in branch to let customers know about this decision.
