Local Public Consultation Decision

I am writing further to my letter dated 13 February 2018, which confirmed that we will be proceeding with our proposal to restore Post Office services to the communities of St Merryn, St Issey, St Kew Highway, Tintagel, South Petherwin, Port Isaac and Rock, with the introduction of a Post Office Mobile service.

Due to operational reasons the service did not commence on Monday 19 March 2018 as previously advised and please accept our apologies regarding this. I am pleased to confirm the Mobile Post Office service for Tintagel , St Issey and Port Isaac commenced on Wednesday 11 April 2018. The Mobile Post Office service for St Merryn, St Kew Highway and Rock commenced on Thursday 12 April 2018 and South Petherwin Mobile Post Office service commenced on Friday 13 April 2018.

We received 62 individual comments from customers and local representatives during the consultation period. This feedback was mainly in support of the changes as it will enable us to reinstate Post Office services in St Merryn, St Issey, St Kew Highway, Tintagel, South Petherwin, Port Isaac and Rock. The communities welcomed the restoration of Post Office services to the above villages, which currently have no Post Office services. However, there was slight concern about the location of our proposed Mobile sites and the visiting days of the Mobile service at some of the locations.

This feedback enabled me to improve my understanding of customers' concerns and to ensure that all such information was taken into account before finalising our plans for the new service. I fully understand the concerns raised regarding the proposed location for the Mobile Service for some of the above communities. Having taken these concerns into consideration, I am happy to confirm that we have changed the location of St Merryn, Tintagel, Port Isaac, Rock and South Petherwin Mobile service to reflect those concerns.


I have carefully considered our original proposal and the feedback received during the public consultation period. I am confident that the new services for St Kew Highway and St Issey are suitably located and along with the re-sited service to St Merryn, Tintagel, Port Isaac, Rock and South Petherwin this new way of offering Mobile Post Office services will meet customer needs in these areas. Full details of these services and changes are provided at the end of this letter.

We do understand that for some customers the new mobile service times may be less convenient, however, we do consider that changing the hours for the mobile service can still meet the needs of our customers in the rural communities and allow us to maintain sustainable services to them in the longer term. We will, however, continue to review and monitor service on an on-going basis and should customer usage increase significantly, consideration would be given to adjusting service times accordingly.

Posters will now be displayed locally to let customers know about this decision.
