Changes to your branch

We recently asked your views on some key areas of our plans to franchise Truro Post Office. In total we received 14 responses.

Thank you to everyone who took the time to let us have their comments and provide information. All the feedback we received helped us to better understand the views of customers and their representatives and this was taken into account, along with all other relevant factors, in finalising our plans.

After careful consideration of the feedback received, we are confident that the new branch will continue to meet customer needs and deliver an excellent service, whilst securing the long-term viability of Post Office services in Truro.

A summary of the key issues raised and our response to each key issue is enclosed, along with an information sheet providing further details about the branch.

The branch will remain at its current location, but to enable us to make the necessary changes to the branch, it will be necessary for it to close at 17:30 on Monday 18 February 2019 and reopen at 09:00 on Wednesday 20 February 2019.

During the transfer of the branch, customers requiring Post Office facilities may use any convenient Post Office service. Details of two nearby alternative Post Office branches are provided below for your information:

- Trelander Post Office, 4 The Quadrant, Trelander, Truro, TR1 1FX
- Threemilestone Post Office, Hugus Road, Threemilestone, Truro, TR3 6GD

For this short period of closure, for customers requiring DVLA Photocard Driving Licence renewal and Security Industry Authority (SIA) licence application services the nearest branch is: Redruth Post Office, 61 Fore Street, Redruth, TR15 2AA, approximately 8.9 miles away. For customers requiring Biometric Enrolment for the Home Office services, the nearest branch is: Plymouth Post Office, 73-85 New George Street, PL1 1RP approximately 47 miles away.

I am confident that our customers in Truro will continue to receive a high standard of customer service in the years ahead.
