**Walthamstow Central Post Office®  
206 High Street, Walthamstow E17 7JH**

The relocation of Walthamstow Central Post Office has been temporarily delayed whilst work at the new premises is completed. Services will therefore continue to be provided from the current site until the new Post Office is ready.

The Post Office announced in July that the branch would move a short distance from its current location at 206 High Street, Walthamstow E17 7JH to retail premises at 242-244 Hoe Street, Walthamstow, E17 3AX, where it will be run on a franchise basis by our new retail partner alongside their retail offer of a convenience store.

Therefore, to allow us to continue to provide a service in this locality a temporary partner will operate the branch at its current site from 6 September 2018. To enable us to transfer the service to our temporary partner, the above Post Office will be temporarily closed from 17:30 on 5 September 2018, re-opening at the current location at 13:00 on 6 September 2018.

During this period of temporary closure customers requiring Post Office services may use any convenient Post Office branch. Details of nearby alternative services are shown below:

- High Street (48) Post Office, 48 High Street, Walthamstow, E17 7LD

A revised date for the opening of the new branch will be confirmed as soon as possible, posters will be displayed in branch to let customers know the new relocation date.
