Local Public Consulation Decision

We are writing to confirm that we will be proceeding with the relocation of the above branch to Southern Co-op, 134 Cromwell Road, Whitstable, CT5 2AA, where it will operate as one of our new main style Post Office branches.

We received 7 individual responses from customers during the local public consultation period. The main feedback centred on parking and the location of the new premises. This feedback enabled me to improve my understanding of customers' concerns and to ensure that all such information was taken into account before finalising our plans for the new branch.

I appreciate that the proposed premises are approximately 450 metres from the current site, and for some customers this may mean a slightly longer journey. In situations such as this there will always be some customers who are more inconvenienced than others and we can only apologise for this. Equally, there may be some customers for whom the premises is slightly closer and more convenient than at present.

It is clear that the Post Office plays an important part in the lives of customers, particularly to older customers and disabled customers and we want to make our services as accessible as possible. I am pleased to confirm that the new Post Office branch will provide level access and wide automatic doors at the entrance. I am also pleased to confirm that before the new Post Office opens, the new operator will plans to install a bicycle rack outside their premises and customers will still be able to tie their pets to the posts outside at the front of the shop should they wish.

While I acknowledge the concerns raised about parking in the area, it is fair to say that this is a problem faced in many locations nationwide. When looking at service provision in an area, we are mindful of the needs of our customers. As I am sure you will understand, the availability of parking spaces is an issue outside the direct control of Post Office Ltd. However I have conducted a further review of this matter. I can confirm that there is a car park, including one disabled bay in the car park. I am therefore satisfied that there is adequate parking at and in the vicinity of the new branch to meet customer requirements following the move.

Internally, the new main style branch will be built in line with Post Office specifications with a dedicated Post Office area, incorporating two security screened, with low level facilities and separate queuing area for Post Office customers. We have been working closely with the new operator to plan the interior layout, to ensure optimum use of the space within the store and that access into and inside is kept clear and free of obstacles. Aisles and the queuing area will be kept free from obstructions and adequate room will be provided for customers and a wheelchair to move around without difficulty. This will ensure the Post Office counter area is easily accessible and customers including a wheelchair user, have sufficient space to move around whilst conducting their business.

Customers will be able to transact the same wide range of products and services as currently, whilst benefitting from longer opening times on Saturdays.

Additionally, there will be a Post Office serving point located at the retail counter where customers can access the majority of Post Office products and services alongside retail transactions. This serving point will be open seven days a week and will offer significantly longer opening times than the main Post Office counter outside of main counter opening times, allowing customers to transact the majority of Post Office products and services alongside retail transactions across seven days a week and at times that are more for convenient for them. Full details of the new branch are at the end of this letter.

I have carefully considered our original proposal, the feedback received during the local public consultation period and the impact on local residents and the wider community. Having also reviewed pedestrian and vehicular access to the new site, I am confident that this move will allow customers good access to Post Office services whilst helping to provide long term viability and future sustainability for Post Office service provision in the local community.

The current branch will close at 17:30 on Tuesday 30 January 2018, with the new branch opening at Southern Co-op, 134 Cromwell Road, Whitstable, CT5 2AA at 13:00 on Friday 02 February 2018. If there are any unforeseen schedule changes which mean these dates change, posters will be displayed in branch to let customers know. During transfer of the branch customers requiring Post Office facilities may use any convenient Post Office service.
