## **Local Public Consultation Decision**

I'm writing to confirm that we will be proceeding with our proposal to move the above Post Office branch to One Stop, 9 Cornerswell Road, Penarth, Cardiff, CF64 2UW, where it will be known as Cornerswell Road Post Office and operate as one of our new local style Post Office branches. Cornerswell Road Post Office aims to secure Post Office services to the local community for the longer term by providing a more modern and commercially viable service. Please accept our apologies for the late notification in this instance, this was due to finalising our plans for the new branch.

As you may recall from our previous letter, the current site is no longer available for Post Office use and branch closed on Wednesday 30 August 2017. In order to maintain a Post Office service the new branch will open at One Stop, 9 Cornerswell Road on Monday 18 December 2017 at 13:00.

We received 45 individual comments from customers during the local public consultation period. The main feedback welcomed reinstating a Post Office service in One Stop, which will be used by the local community in Penarth and will help maintain Post Office services locally. Customers also said it would be easier to get to the new branch and liked the longer opening times. Other comments expressed concerns about access, space, privacy and the lack of parking at the proposed location and the impact this could have on local residents.

While I have considered the concerns raised about parking in the area surrounding the new location, it is fair to say that this is a problem faced generally in many locations nationwide. As I am sure you will understand the availability of parking spaces is outside the direct control of Post Office Limited. However I have conducted a further review of parking and I can confirm there is roadside parking available on Ivy Street and there is also time restricted parking available opposite the premises on Cornerswell Road. I am therefore satisfied that parking at the proposed new branch will continue to meet the needs of customers using the Post Office. However, the new operator will also be approaching the relevant authority to seek a review of disabled parking in the area and explore the possibility of a disabled bay near to the new premises.

We recognise that the Post Office plays an important part in the lives of customers, particularly for our older and less able customers, and we want to make our services as accessible as possible. Inside One Stop, the new branch will be in line with Post Office specifications, making sure there is sufficient space for the new style local Post Office to operate alongside the retail offer. We will be working closely with the new operator on the internal layout and some fixtures and fittings will be re-aligned or removed to make sure there is clear access into the premises. Aisles and the queuing area will be kept free from obstructions and adequate room will be provided for customers and a wheelchair to move around the shop and access Post Office services. I can confirm the access will be via a permanent ramp with a wide door.

We will also be working with the new operator to make sure there is an appropriate level of privacy at the Post Office serving point. For example, we discuss issues like queue layout and asking customers to stand back from the counter whilst they are waiting for service. Staff training is to Post Office standards and includes instructions and guidelines to safeguard customer privacy and confidentiality. Similarly with security, as with any other branch in our network there would be strict guidelines and measures put in place to safeguard customers, staff and the cash and stock entrusted to the operator's care.

The new local style Post Office will operate from two Post Office serving points located at the shop counter, enabling customers to carry out a wide range of Post Office products and services alongside retail transactions. The Post Office transactions are designed to be quick and efficient to enable fast and effective customer service and helping to reduce queuing. This does mean that a small number of transactions that are more time consuming, complex or paper based won't be available at the new branch. The very small range of services that will no longer be offered, can be accessed at Penrath Post Office, which offers the full range of Post Office products and services and can be reached by a direct bus service.

The change also means that customers will benefit from extensive opening hours, including Saturday afternoon, Sunday opening and longer opening times throughout the week, so they can use our services seven days a week and at times that suit them better. Further details of the new branch are provided at the end of this letter together with a list of the products and services which will be available.

I have carefully considered our original proposal, the feedback received during the local public consultation period along with the impact on local residents and the wider community. Having also reviewed pedestrian and vehicular access to the new site, I am confident that the new branch is suitably located and that this new way of offering Post Office services will meet customer needs, whilst helping to provide long term viability and future sustainability for Post Office service provision in the local community.
